SAVAYA

It's chic, exciting and unlike anything else on the island – Savaya is Uluwatu's sky-high destination that's shining an international light on Bali's luxury lifestyle scene. This luxe playground is chock full of fabulous cocktails, and of course, million-dollar views. And, with some big hospitality names behind it, you can also expect good vibrations from superstar DJs and VIP events.

SUNDAY BEACH CLUB

A heady mixture of powder white sand and azure ocean, Sundays Beach Club is tucked away at the edge of the world with a heavenly combo of sun, sea and sand . In fact, this Bali bucket list staple is one of few beach clubs that actually sits directly on the beach, letting you spend the entire day with your toes in the sand. Take the cliff-side escalator down to this hidden oasis for the ultimate beach experience

BEST CAFES

ALCHEMY

Alchemy Uluwatu is a plant-based restaurant located at Jalan Pantai Bingin No. 8, Pecatu, Badung, Bali. The venue features a ranch-style setting with a permaculture garden and a central bonfire pit lit every evening. The menu includes breakfast, salad, ice cream, and waffle bars, offering smoothie bowls, salads, vegan waffles, and soft-serve ice cream.

DRIFTER

A shrine to all things old school surf, Drifter proudly wears its vintage vibes badge, stocking a range of underground labels and some of the most beautiful ocean-inspired art around. Browse the shop and when you're done, head out the back to the peaceful garden café area where you'll find excellent coffee and a range of deliciously healthy dishes.

BANANA LOUNGE

Bring an appetite and your bikini, because Banana Lounge is Bingin's pool lounge and restaurant where you can graze all day on wholesome bites, sip your way through carefully curated cocktails, and take a break poolside, soaking in the sunshine and breezy Bingin vibes. Come early for brunch and freshly-brewed coffee, then stick around to feast on pan-seared fish, beef skewers or the bucket of 12 salted prawns to share

NOURISH

Delicious, organic and locally sourced, Nourish does exactly that: it nourishes your tummies with nutrient-rich foods, cold-pressed juices, healthy salads and superfood bowls. This all-day cafe and pizzeria has two locations in the Bukit; one in Ungasan and the other in Bingin, with the latter attached to its very own gourmet wholefoods store.





NIGHTLIFE

SINGLE FIN

A long standing favourite amongst Uluwatu surf crowds, Single Fin is a restaurant, bar and club teetering atop the cliffs and overlooking Bali's most famous surf breaks. From day to night, it's always packed here, with great pizzas, cocktail jugs and an impressive roster of live bands and DJs, all surrounded by good vibes. Drop by any day of the week, but don't miss the legendary Sunday Sessions...

HATCH

A restaurant by day, as the sun sets Hatch transforms into a wild fiesta with psychedelic interiors made entirely of recycled materials. Late-night dancing and live DJ performances bring in the crowds, and each night is a different theme, from ladies night to games night and everything in between.

TABU

Tabu Supper Club is Uluwatu's first supper club, a combination of Mexican spirit and Japanese elegance. It is an intimate venue that can seat 20 diners along a long table, perfect for socializing and enjoying the music and the food. Tabu Supper Club offers a fusion of Mexican and Japanese dishes, such as tacos, sushi, ceviche, and teppanyaki.

THINGS TO DO



SURF & SUNSET WALK

Right up there with the world's very best surfing destinations, Uluwatu's waves are high priority on every board rider's itinerary. Novices need not apply – the waves here regularly barrel onto sharp reef with strong currents to boot, attracting pros (and wannabes) from around the world. Bingin, Impossible, Padang Padang or Balangan are your to-go spot. Learning to surf? Try nearby Jimbaran instead, or try Balangan or Dreamland during a smaller swell.

ULUWATU TEMPLE

Arguably Bali's most breathtaking temple with its ocean backdrop and dizzying perch, Pura Luhur Uluwatu is a must-visit if you're looking for awesome and cultural things to do in Uluwatu. Located high above the crashing waves, this sacred temple was built for the spirits of the sea in the 10th century, laced with ancient architecture, intricate sacred sculptures, and... hundreds of monkeys.

SHOPPING

With its laid-back island vibes, it's no wonder Uluwatu is home to an entire collection of humble boutiques selling all of your beach essentials – most of which are made right here on the island. You'll find Bali-born bikinis from ELCE and FAE, island-grown ocean apparel at Drifter (Uluwatu's OG surf hub) and even homewares and island vacay essentials from Cove – a lifestyle boutique that slings boho beachwear, limited edition artwork and impeccably handcrafted treasures.

WATERBOM

Waterbom Bali is an exhilarating water park located in Kuta, Bali, offering a thrilling array of slides, pools, and attractions for visitors of all ages. With its lush tropical surroundings, exhilarating rides, and family-friendly atmosphere, Waterbom Bali provides a refreshing escape from the island's heat and a fun-filled day out for families, friends, and adventure-seekers alike.



THE ANAK ATELIER

The Anak Atelier is an international preschool and kindergarten that is not only meant for families living in Bali. Between 3 pm to 5 pm, they open their doors for everyone to come and play in their sprawling garden and kids club. The outdoor area features a natural stream, a sand-pit, mud-kitchen, expansive lawns to run around on, swings, slides, holes and climbing racks



PAINT-A-POT AT JENGALA KERAMIK

You will find the most beautiful ceramics at Jenggala Bali but what's even better, you can drop in for a workshop at the main flagship store in Jimbaran (on the way to Uluwatu).
